4. Discuss what Jesus meant in vv. 22-23 by bringing up the eye as the lamp of the body.
5. Why is it impossible to serve both God and money?
6. In vv. 25-34 Jesus asks several rhetorical questions to get us to not worry. What are they and which is most powerful to you?
7. Is there a situation you are in where you can trust God and thus demonstrate a different approach to life than “pagans” around you? Explain.
8. What are some tangible ways you can seek first his kingdom and his righteousness?
9. At the end of his sermon, Mark gave two suggestions for battling worry. What are they? How can you apply those to your own life?
