2. Read 2 Corinthians 1:1; Acts 9:3-9, 15-16. Consider Paul's past, his conversion, his calling, his successes, and his hardships...What are some things about the life of Paul that helps you understand God better?
3. What have you learned personally about God's calling? How do we personally navigate God's calling and leading?
4. How does Paul's own life and legacy help you evaluate what is important to your own life and legacy?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 1:2. How do you explain grace? How does the availability of God's grace actually transform a life?

6. How does the message Paul preached help us know peace amidst the chaos and disruption in life?
7. How does the “Paradox of the Cross” taught by Paul’s words and demonstrated by Paul’s actions challenge your priorities?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 12:9. Has there been a circumstance in your life where you saw the principle of God’s power made perfect in your weakness?
9. What is a particular weakness where you need God’s grace to move powerfully?
How can your community group encourage you in your circumstance?
